Please review the following Miami Arts Studio 6-12 Magnet Contract.

PLEASE NOTE: In order to reach their academic goals and prepare for future educational experiences, students enrolling in the Magnet program must comply with the following requirements and expectations to remain enrolled:

ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE:

- Maintain a grade point average of 2.0 or higher in all Magnet courses and a 2.0 overall in all core courses each year.
A final grade of "F" (Magnet and core courses) may result in exiting the program at the end of the school year.
- Maintain a minimum of a 2 in effort for Magnet and core courses.

- Excessive referrals will result in a behavioral contract, probation, and possible exit at the end of the school year.
- Students who violate Level II, III, IV, or V of the Code of Student Conduct will not be allowed to return to the Magnet program and may be dismissed at the time of the violation.

BEHAVIOR AND CONDUCT:

- Maintain a conduct grade of "C" or higher in all Magnet and core courses each year.
- *Violation of the **Miami-Dade County Public Schools Code of Student Conduct** may result in probation or possible immediate exit from the program.*

ATTENDANCE:

- A student who has ten (10) or more cumulative absences will not be allowed to participate in competitions or performances for the remainder of the school year.
- A student who has twenty (20) or more cumulative tardies will not be allowed to participate in competitions or performances for the remainder of the school year.
- *Violation of the above policy may result in probation and possible removal at the end of the school year.*

Academic, Behavior, Conduct, and Attendance are continuously monitored. Listed below are the three (3) notices in sequential order:

- **After the first violation of a grading period:**
 - **Probation Letter:** This notice informs the student and parents of which areas need improvement.
- **After the second violation of a grading period:**
 - **Probation Letter/Conference:** Students not meeting expectations will meet with parents, counselors, and lead teacher to assist student. The student may be denied participation in non-academic field trips, performances, or exhibitions.
- **After the third violation of a grading period:**
 - **Final Notice/Exit Conference:** A final parent conference is required at this point. The student will not be eligible to continue in the magnet program the following school year and must, therefore, be re-enrolled at the home school. After the final conference, the student is permitted to remain at Miami Arts Studio for the rest of the school year.

All students at **Miami Arts Studio 6-12** must adhere to the requirements of **Miami Arts Studio 6-12 Parent/Student Handbook and Code of Student Conduct**, along with the following requirements:

- A student scheduled to attend a field trip or to participate in a performance or school-sponsored event is required to attend school on the day of the trip, performance, or event. Students are also required to attend school the day before and after they participate in field trips, performances, and school-sponsored events.
- Performing arts students are required to fully participate in rehearsals, performances, field trips, and competitions as designated by their arts faculty and must consider this participation a priority over any outside school activities.
